Let Your Light Shine

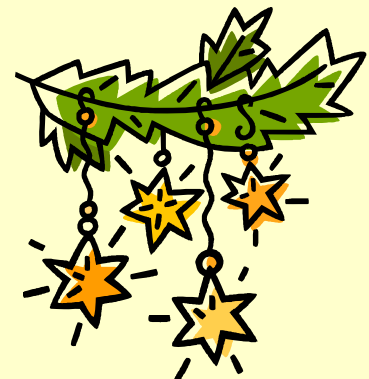
